## Timeline - Program Reviews are a 2 year process

- Program faculty starts self-study in the semester indicated in the table above. Self-study takes one academic year to complete and is due June 15<sup>th</sup> of year 1.
- 2) The following academic year, an external reviewer completes a site visit preferably by Dec. 15<sup>th</sup>, submits an external reviewer's report, and the department submits a response to the external reviewer's report by April 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 3) Each of the three documents (self-study, external reviewer's report, and department response) are submitted electronically to the Dean, Provost, and the Director of Assessment by the above given due dates.
- 4) The Dean will review the three documents by June 30<sup>th</sup> of year 2, will provide feedback to the Provost and the department, and the Dean will feed the appropriate recommendations into the College's workplan for the following year(s).
