## Timeline - Program Reviews are a 2 year process

- 1) Program faculty starts **self-study** in the semester indicated in the table above. Self-study takes one academic year to complete and is due **June 15**<sup>th</sup> of year 1.
- 2) The following academic year, an **external reviewer** completes a **site visit** preferably by **Dec. 15**<sup>th</sup>, submits an external reviewer's **report**, and the department submits a **response** to the external reviewer's report by **April 15**<sup>th</sup>.
- 3) **Each of the three documents** (self-study, external reviewer's report, and department response) **are submitted electronically to the Dean, Provost, and the Director of Assessment** by the above given due dates.
- 4) The Dean will review the three documents by June 30<sup>th</sup> of year 2, will provide feedback to the Provost and the department, and the Dean will feed the appropriate recommendations into the College's workplan for the following year(s).
