

Temporary Housing Agreement

You are being provided with a temporary housing space on the campus of Western New England University (WNE). Below are the responsibilities associated with living in temporary housing. Please read them all and sign below to confirm that you have read and agree to these conditions.

As a resident in temporary housing at WNE, I understand and agree to the following:

- I am a student at WNE for the upcoming semester.
- I agree to pay the charges associated with temporary housing, which are \$30 per night, or \$100 per week for those who have pre-registered.
- While living on campus, I will follow all federal, state and local laws. This includes, but is not limited to, not possessing or consuming alcohol under the age of 21, not possessing or consuming illegal drugs (including marijuana) and not bringing weapons onto University property.
- I understand that there is no smoking in any building on campus including the residence halls; smoking is allowed 25 feet away from any door, window or ventilation unit.
- I understand that, as a student, I am responsible for becoming familiar with all University policies, and violation of any University policy while I'm living in temporary housing will result in an appropriate response by the University, which can include, but is not limited to, immediate removal from temporary housing.
- I will remain in temporary housing on campus for no longer than two weeks. Failure to vacate temporary housing within two weeks of the arrival date will result in additional charges as deemed appropriate by the University.
- While living in temporary housing, I may decide that I want to live on campus for the rest of the semester/year. If that happens, I understand that I will need to move from the temporary space to a permanent space on campus.***
- When I leave temporary housing, I will return my room key to Public Safety. If I lose my room key, I understand that replacement of the key and a lock change for the room will result in a \$100 charge to my student account.
- When I leave temporary housing, I will place all the linens provided (if linens were provided) back into the bag they came in, and leave the bag on one of the beds in the room so it can be collected after I leave. Failure to return linens that were provided will result in a \$50 replacement charge.
- I also understand that any damage to any University property in my room while I am in temporary housing will result in a charge to my student account for the appropriate amount associated with the damage.
