2023-2024 Verification Worksheet

To verify that you provided correct information the financial aid administrator will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You, and at least one parent if you are a dependent student, must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and required documents to Enrollment Services. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact Enrollment Services as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.
