Dear first year students,

The Law School Registrar welcomes you to Western New England University School of Law. This letter contains information about registration for courses in the fall 2026 semester.

All students will be registered for LAW 500, Introduction to Law. This course will meet in person at the School of Law for all students from August 24 to August 27. Your schedule for orientation will provide class session times along with the schedule for other required orientation sessions. All other classes will begin on August 31.

**Full time students and part-time day students** will be assigned to one of two sections (A or B) which will have the following schedules. All meeting times are in person at the School of Law.

#### Section A

- LAW 695, Academic Success: Students in Section A will be assigned to one of two smaller sections, both of which meet on Tuesdays 10:00 am - 10:55 am.
- LAW 513-03, Torts: Tuesday from 2:00 pm to 3:15 pm, Wednesdays from 10:35 am to 11:50 am, and Thursdays from 9:30 am to 10:15 am.
- LAW 509-03, Civil Procedure: Mondays from 10:35 am to 11:50 am and Tuesdays from 11:10 am to 12:25 pm. This course will also have asynchronous online content that is the time- and preparation- equivalent of one class session each week.
- LAW 505-03, Criminal Law: Only full-time students will be registered for Criminal Law. This course will meet on Mondays and Wednesdays from 1:00 pm to 2:15 pm and Thursdays from 11:00 am to 12:15 pm.
- LAW 507, Lawyering Skills I: Students will be assigned to one of several smaller sections, all of which meet on Monday and Wednesdays from 9:30 am to 10:25 am.

#### Section B

- LAW 695, Academic Success: Students in Section B will be assigned to one of two smaller sections, both of which meet on Thursdays 10:00 am - 10:55 am.
- LAW 513-05, Torts: Tuesday from 11:10 am to 12:25 pm, Wednesdays from 1:00 pm to 2:15 pm, and Thursdays from 2:00 pm to 3:15 pm.
- LAW 509-05, Civil Procedure: Mondays from 1:00 pm to 2:15 pm and Tuesdays from 2:00 pm to 3:15 pm. This course will also have asynchronous online content that is the time- and preparation- equivalent of one class session each week.
- LAW 505-05, Criminal Law: Only full-time students will be registered for Criminal Law. This course will meet on Mondays and Wednesdays from 10:35 am to 11:50 am and Thursdays from 11:05 am to 12:20 pm.
- LAW 507, Lawyering Skills I: Students will be assigned to one of several smaller sections, all of which meet on Mondays and Wednesdays from 2:30 pm to 3:25 pm.
