<u>Full-time students</u> should register for 12 credits. Please make sure that you have completed all required courses, including LLME 806: Final Drafting Project. Additionally, you should complete 10 credits of elective courses. To review program requirements please see the <u>curriculum overview</u>.

<u>**Part-time students**</u> should register for 4 credits (three-year program) or 6 credits (two-year program) per semester although you may take more or less. Please make sure that you are on track to complete all required courses, including LLME 806: Final Drafting Project. Additionally, you should complete 10 credits of elective courses.
