3. TEACHING INNOVATIONS FOR ON CAMPUS AND DISTANCE LEARNING.

Campus Innovation

Adams, B.

The Department of Occupational Therapy received approval for the launch of the extended OTD program (OTDx) beginning in Fall 2025. This program, offered to on-campus and distance students, follows the same curriculum as our full-time distance and in-person pathways, but at a slower pace that provides increased accessibility to a degree in occupational therapy. This is an extended, four-year (11-semester) program

For this program, OTD students can apply to complete a 3rd Level Two fieldwork placement during their 7th semester in the program, whereas industry standards across most occupational therapy education programs only require 2 Level Two fieldwork placements. This pilot program is being launched to further push the boundaries of excellence and preparedness for graduates of the Doctor of Occupational Therapy Program as they get ready to enter the workforce.

Whitman-Jemison, A.

Distance Learning Innovations

The Department of Occupational Therapy launched its Distance Learning Cohort (DLC) in Fall 2024, welcoming nine DLC students to our blended learning curriculum. The DLC is overseen by Dr. Erin Wells, our Distance Learning Coordinator. Since the fall we have hosted five successful immersive sessions which take place at midterm and final of each semester. Our hybrid curriculum uses a synchronous delivery model to students online and in person simultaneously. The DLC has been thriving due to faculty and staff commitment to learning and embracing new technology, as well as student feedback and open mindedness about what a learning environment looks like. As part of the DLC, our experiential affairs team has been committed to identifying fieldwork sites close to home and are placing our students in multiple fieldwork sites per semester, in addition to the placements for our more local, on-campus students. We look forward to welcoming our next cohort of DLC students in the fall

and are preparing for the additional workload and additional technology that will be utilized in order to maintain this high level of success with our program.

The BEAR PAW Center, a pro bono, student-run occupational therapy center, is now providing services to clients through the lifespan via both in-person and telehealth services. With the addition of the DLC, the development of our Telehealth Center was a necessary and exciting addition in order to ensure our distance students have access to the same opportunities as our on-campus students. The telehealth services students are providing are overseen by alumna Dr. Nicole Kloss and have received excellent feedback from our clients.
