

Drop-In Tutoring FAQ

What is drop-in tutoring?

The Academic Success Center (ASC) Drop-in Tutoring program provides free peer tutoring for specific 100-200-level undergraduate courses. We coordinate a schedule of weekly sessions for each semester, typically beginning in the first few weeks and continuing through the last week of classes.

Who are the ASC drop-in tutors?

Our ASC drop-in tutors are current WNE students who have excelled in the courses they support, been recommended by faculty, and completed our training program. Our drop-in tutors are passionate about supporting their fellow Golden Bears and are excited to work with you!

Where is drop-in tutoring?

Drop-in tutoring locations vary per class each semester, and schedules will be posted around campus, on the ASC website, and via University Posts. Any changes to locations or time frames are announced campus wide.

What should I expect at drop-in tutoring?

Students are expected to come prepared with questions and topics they wish to cover at drop-in tutoring. Although drop-in tutors are unable to complete graded coursework with you, they can help break down the concepts, formulas, and steps necessary for you to complete your assignments and prepare for tests in alignment with WNE's academic integrity policies. Tutors are trained to provide all students that attend with support and study tips. They strive to help you feel more confident in the course material.

What should I bring to the drop-in tutoring sessions?

Bring your course materials (i.e. syllabus, handouts, lectures etc.), questions, and your class notes. Bring the device(s) you need to pull up your Kodiak Canvas classroom as not all drop-in sessions take place in computer lab spaces. These materials will help your tutor understand how to best help you.

What if I am unable to attend any drop-in tutoring sessions?

If circumstances prevent you from attending the scheduled drop-in tutoring sessions, please contact academicsuccess@wne.edu. ASC staff will discuss alternative arrangements with you.

How many drop-in tutoring sessions can I attend per week?

You can attend as many drop-in tutoring sessions as are offered for your requested course(s) each week.

What if I am late for a drop-in tutoring session?

That is okay! Students can arrive at drop-in tutoring during any point in the scheduled two-hour sessions and stay for as little or as long as they wish. We aim to provide you with as much support as possible, so the earlier you arrive, the more tutoring you will receive. Note, the tutor cannot stay past the designated end of the session.

If I have a one-on-one tutor for a course, can I still go to drop-in peer tutoring?

Yes, you can. Drop-in tutoring is open to all students enrolled in the courses on the current semester schedule.
